The Mahwah Public Library will continue showing movies on Thursday afternoons using the high resolution digital projector and sound system (a Hitachi CP-X444 Multimedia LCD Projector) on the 10' x 18' screen. "Mamma Mia" Thursday November 5, 2009 at 1:30 PM

Tunes from the Swedish '70s pop group ABBA provide the backdrop for this 2001 Broadway musical. Sophie and her mom run an inn on a Greek island and are preparing for Sophie's wedding. Sophie wants her dad whom she's never known to attend. The problem is that her dad can be one of three men. Meryl Streep sings. PG-13 2008 (108 minutes)

"Bye Bye Birdie" Thursday November 12, 2009 at 1:30 PM

Just back on Broadway, this film version features Dick Van Dyke from the original Broadway cast. A teen rock and roll idol (think Elvis) is coming to a small town to see one of his fans before he leaves for the army. G 1963 (112 minutes)

"South Pacific" Thursday November 19, 2009 at 1:30 PM

Glenn Close is Nellie Forbush (in a made-for-TV version) a nurse stationed on an island in the South Pacific during World War II. More than just a musical this Pulitzer prize-winning Broadway classic examined whether "we've got to be taught to hate and fear". G 2001 (129 minutes)

These films are free. The library will provide popcorn and drink. No tickets are necessary. Seats are on a "first come" basis.
